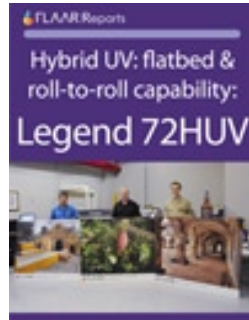
This hybrid printer from DEC is not being manufactured any more. The printer is still probably available, but is no longer an active model.
